## Start around 3 or 4 O'clock

Style "Le Mans" - Boat in the water ready to start held by the crew, Skipper on shore by the Race officer.

## Course

From the beach to virtual Mark 1 (for clearing the canal entrance only) to Mark 2 (The Spider) ~3. 24 nautical miles.

From Mark 2 to Mark 3 (aka Walker Line -3 yellow markers) ~ 4.74 nautical miles
From Mark 3 to Finish ~ 2.76 nautical miles.
The Finish is on Beach by the Race Officer Flag. Once Catamaran is beached either the Skipper or Crew run over to the Race Officer and gives them a High Five. Your finish time is only capture once High Five is completed. (We suspect there might be some beach sprints happening if the race is close ().)

Shorten course. The organiser may shorten or change the course before going out.
All Marks 2 and 3 should be left on port side unless the race is reversed then Marks 2 , 3 should be left on starboard side.

Target is to be back on shore before 6 pm depending on the wind.

You agree to enter this fun long-distance event by respecting the swimming area, understanding that NO Race officer would be supervising the race and sail in a fair play.

VHF will be permitted with all members listening to channel 70 in case of an emergency.
