ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Boat insurance and proof of liability coverage required totaling \$100,000.

For Hobie Class points regatta, a HCANA Membership is required. All participants must be a current member of the HCANA (Hobie Class Association North America). If you don't want to pay a full membership, you will have to pay a light membership of 40 \$CAN (30\$US) in support of our class, good for 1 event.

HCANA Membership would be verified at the registration desk at the venue.

Directions from Toronto and Windsor.

Toronto: From the Gardiner Expressway, head west, take QEW towards Niagara.

Detroit - Windsor: 401 East past London, then 403 East towards Hamilton, then QEW Niagara.

All: Once heading on QEW Niagara, (roughly 1.5km) take North Shore Boulevard exit, (Before the Skyway bridge) T intersection turn left on North Shore Blvd. Go just past Joseph Brant Hospital and turn right on Lakeshore Road (the first stoplight) - You will see the lake on your left. Go about 1.3 km and you are there! Enter the last parking lot on the left.
